"It was like a Dream" was created winter 2008 using charcoal and measures about 19" x 24."




This oil painting was completed winter 2007 and measures 24" x 36." This painting was completed using a layered technique and took about ten weeks to complete.







The following photographs were created summer 2009 during my internship for a medical supply company for use on their website and their printed catalog.






"Cactus and Glove" was created fall 2008. The photographs were placed together to envoke certain feelings like mystery, strangeness, and pain in the viewer.
